South Carolina Governor's Cup Billfishing Series

The SC Governor's Cup Billfishing Series occurs annually and includes multiple South Carolina billfish tournaments. Boats participating in the Series accumulate points for billfish either landed or released. Boats compete for three major awards: Outstanding Billfish (single heaviest billfish), Outstanding Billfish Boat (most accumulated points), and Billfish Conservationist (most points for released fish). The Series has contributed valuable data on these beautiful blue water species, while also encouraging conservation of our marine resources.

Goals

- Promote conservation, research, and education.
- Increase coastal tourism.
- Support the SC billfishing industry.

Major Accomplishments

- Prior to the SC Governor's Cup Billfishing Series, <10% of billfish were released.
- Now, >90% of billfish are released.
- As part of the SC Memorial Reef project, funds were raised to sink two barges, the old Highway 41 swing bridge, and a 247-ft cargo ship in the Charleston Deep Reef MPA, a Type II MPA which allows for trolling but no bottom fishing.
- Annual scholarships are awarded through the W.F. Pate Memorial Conservation Fund. To date, 18 scholarships have been awarded.
- Following satellite tagging of billfish from 2002-2007, Bubley et al. (2020) published a paper evaluating sailfish habitat use and overlap with other billfish species.
- In 1997, the Blue Water Conservation award was initiated, which recognized the boat that tagged and released the most dolphin, wahoo, or tuna.
- In 1993, the Series received the South Carolina Wildlife Federation's Outdoor Ethics Conservation Award.

Four tournaments were held, including one in Georgetown, two near Charleston, and one in Edisto.
