Below is a list of some of the permits, licenses, and documentation that you will need to have in your possession so that boat owners, captains, and crew are ready for a successful fishing season. (NOTE: Double check expiration dates!)

1) SC Saltwater Fishing License – Every individual (age 16 and above) aboard the vessel must have a valid, official SC Saltwater Recreational Fishing License in their possession. These licenses can be purchased at https://license.gooutdoorssouthcarolina.com/Licensing/CustomerLookup.aspx.

2) Current vessel documentation or state registration – All vessels must possess current and valid state registration or US Coast Guard documentation in addition to being titled in the owner's name/business. For vessel registration information, please visit <u>https://vessel.gooutdoorssouthcarolina.com/Vessel/CustomerLookup.aspx</u>.

3) Atlantic HMS [Angling (Recreational) or Charter/Headboat] **Permit** – All owners/operators of vessels fishing recreationally, or owners/ operators of charter/headboat vessels fishing for and/or retaining regulated Atlantic Highly Migratory Species (HMS; Atlantic tunas, sharks, swordfish, and billfish) in the Atlantic Ocean, including the Gulf of Mexico and Caribbean Sea, must obtain an Atlantic Highly Migratory Species permit, To obtain HMS please visit https:// permit. an hmspermits.noaa.gov/.
