The 2025 Series is here, and we had a fantastic bite for the first three tournaments! So far 71 boats have released a total of 255 billfish — 68 blue marlin, 3 white marlin, and 184 sailfish.

During the Charleston Billfish Invitational, *Viking 74* took home the first place award for Outstanding Billfish Boat after releasing three blue marlin, one white marlin, and three sailfish. At the 57th Annual Georgetown Blue Marlin Tournament, *Claytime* took the win, releasing two blue marlin and six sailfish. *Bull Pen* took home first place at the HMY Lowcountry Cup, releasing four blue marlin and seven sailfish.

The excitement continues with the next two highly anticipated events in the series. The Carolina Billfish Classic is this week, so get your gear ready and your crew fired up! After Fourth of July celebrations and a little break, we'll finish off the season down south for the Edisto Invitational Billfish Tournament.

We're all hoping for calm seas, clears skies, and plenty of billfish in the spread! Whether you're fishing or following from shore, stay tuned for daily updates, weigh-ins, and leaderboard action. Remembering Carroll A. Campbell

A reflection by his granddaughter

My First Catch

I was just three years old when I caught my very first fish—a ladyfish—on a Barbie fishing rod. It happened down in DeBordieu, in Georgetown, while visiting my Nanny and Poppy. My parents took me out on the water behind their house in North Inlet, aboard my Poppy, Carroll Ashmore Campbell Jr.'s boat, a 15-foot Scout that we often took up and down the creek while growing up. That day, I caught the fish all by myself. My mom and dad were over the moon with excitement, and to everyone's surprise, it ended up being the biggest fish caught on the boat that day. That moment was more than just a first catch—it was the beginning of a lifelong connection to the water and to a place filled with cherished memories. After my grandfather passed, I spent many summers at the beach with my Nanny, Iris Campbell, and every visit reminded me of the special bond our family shares with Georgetown. It's a place woven into our family history—one that holds deep meaning, even from those early days with a pink fishing rod in hand.

Knowing that I caught my first fish in the same waters where my grandfather (Poppy) built his legacy is incredibly special. Every time I return to Georgetown, or hear about the Governor's Cup and think about all my grandfather accomplished, I'm not only reminded of him, but of the memories that first fish helped spark.




